International law influences nations and affects people. Often the loudest voices argue that Israel has breached international laws. News reports frequently state that Jewish settlements, Israel's security barrier and self-defense measures violate international law. Many in positions of influence and power have accepted this narrative without critical examination of the evidence. Do such claims reflect an accurate, balanced rendering of international law?

Professors Eugene Kontorovich of Northwestern University and Samuel Estreicher of New York University have brought together an outstanding group of international law scholars to present papers and evaluate these issues. From the Goldstone Report to the legality of settlements, from the Palestinians' claimed right of return to the Arab trade and intellectual exchange boycott and more, the conference will examine the crucial legal issues shaping the seemingly intractable conflict between Arabs and Israel.
